Church at Jerusalem (Acts 8:1)

Church at Antioch (Acts 13:1)

Church at Cenchrea (Romans 16:1)

Church at Corinth (1 Corinthians 1:2)

Local church leadership

The local leadership of the church of Jerusalem explicitly appointed their own deacons (Acts 6:5-6) and implicitly ordained their own elders (Acts 11:30)

The church at Antioch has distinct leadership (Ac 13:1).

Local Church discipline

Apostles in Acts 5

Church leaders (with support from Paul) in 1 Cor 5

Local Church missionaries

Missionaries were sent by and reported back to the sending church (Acts 13-14)

While local churches were independent, there were cooperative, edifying relationships between them.

- Conflicts of membership were handled by sending church leaders to church leaders (Acts 15).
- Local church members would write to other church letters asking from counsel (1 Corinthians 1:10-11).
- Paul, removed from churches, wrote letters of doctrine and exhortation to churches, some of which we have no record of him starting (e.g. Colosse).
- Local churches sent teachers to fledgling churches to support the work (Acts 11:19-28)
- Local churches sent relief to existing churches to help the poor. (Acts 11:27-30).
