Of the 8 billion souls on the planet, 1.5 billion people cannot access the bible in their language. 160 million do not have a single passage of scripture translated in their heart language. As we consider our obedience in fulfilling God's mission of taking the gospel to the ends of the earth, it is imperative that we who hold a faith-based view of scripture take advantage of opportunities God provides to get the word of God into the hearts and hands of every kindred, tongue, people and nation. 

MAP OF THE BUILDING


Upper Level




For those that would like to carpool or caravan down to Union Station, please meet in the main parking lot at Midtown Baptist Temple at 9:15 AM.
