What inheritance is the Holy Spirit sealing promising?

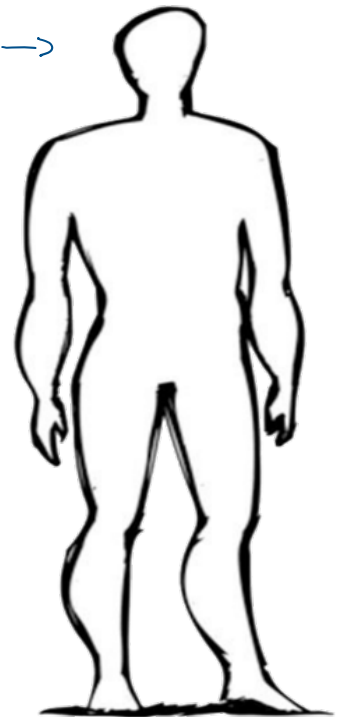
Vs 14. Redemption of the purchased possession.

3. Producing _____! Ephesians 1:3–6, 13

KEY: It is all "in him"

- **Love** of God / evidence of our eternal security.
2 Corinthians 5:17; Romans 8:14–17; 2 Corinthians 1:21–22; 1 John 5:13; 2 Timothy 2:16–19
- **Some need to die to doubt and just get full of faith and LET GOD LOVE THEM.**

Ephesians 4. *We have the WORD of God (vs 11) so we can live the LIFE of God (vs 12-16)*

So that we will NOT LIVE the life of the world (vs 17-19)

How do children of God live? (vs 20-32)
