What is "EXPOSITORY" or "BIBLICAL" Preaching?

EXPOSITORY PREACHING is...

The impartation of **God's truth**, presented in the power of **God's Spirit** for the purpose of edifying **God's people**, so they are conformed to **God's image**, and equipped to fulfill **God's mission**.

Though it certainly includes **teaching**, it is more than just teaching in that it **reproves**, **rebukes**, and **exhorts**. It is, therefore, **convicting**, **confronting**, and **challenging**.

The "preacher" is **authoritative**, and yet **longsuffering**, because the **AUTHORITY** is **outside of himself**. His **authority** is **the word of God**, as evidenced by the - _____ of his message.

It is **EXPOSITIONAL** in that it simply brings out of the text what is **there**, " _____ " it to view. The opposite of "**EXPOSITION**" is "**IMPOSITION**," which " _____ " on the text what is **not there**.
