3. EVERY PERSON IS CONSOLIDATED IN THE EXPRESSIONS OF WORSHIP.

A. Worshipping is expressed biblically through SINGING.

- There are nearly 600 references to people singing praises to God.
- 44 of the 66 Books of the Bible make reference to music.
- The longest Book of the Bible (Psalms) is a song Book!
- God desires and delights in the worship of His children expressed from their hearts through SINGING. (Psalm 69:30-31)
- When we become a Christian we become a singer because He puts a song in our heart and in our mouth. (Psalm 40:3)

B. Worshipping is expressed biblically through <u>GIVING</u>. (Psalm 96:7-9)

- There are approximately 500 verses on prayer in the Bible.
- There are fewer than 500 verses on faith in the Bible.
- There are almost 600 verses on singing in the Bible.
- There are more than 2,350 verses on handling money in the Bible.
- Jesus had more to say about money than He did heaven!
- Jesus had more to say about money than any other subject!

WHY DOES GOD PLACE SUCH AN EMPHASIS ON MONEY?

- 1. Money is the **BAROMETER** of our **HEARTS**.
 - Jeremiah 17:9 -
 - Matthew 6:21 -
 - The subjectivity of our hearts is made very objective by where we invest our money.
 - "You can tell more about a person's character by examining his bank statement than by listening to him talk."
- 2. Money vies for the place of **LORDSHIP** in our lives.
 - Matthew 6:24 -
- 3. Money is the **GAUGE** that reveals whether we can handle the stewardship of **TRUE RICHES**.
 - Luke 16:10-11 -
 - ♦ "True riches" = Riches that are **ETERNAL**.
 - "True riches" = The WORD of GOD and the SOULS of MEN.
