- 3. Examples of this pattern of hiding in fear from God abound. (Turn to Judges 6)
 - Gideon. Judges 6:3–12
 He was hiding until God called him out.
 God used Gideon to turn the world upside down. Judges 7:19–21
 - Saul. 1 Samuel 9
 God raised him up to be a deliverer for Israel.
 When it was time to serve, where do we find him? 1 Samuel 10:20–23

Moses is your ______ to Saul. Hebrews 11:26–27 We know Saul had a BELIEF problem. 1 Samuel 15:22–23

Saul and Israel. 1 Samuel 17:22–24
 They were hiding in fear until God used David to stir them up. 1 Samuel 17:22–29
 David was used of God to do the impossible! 1 Samuel 17:41–53

David was another great contrast to Saul. When called of God, he moved forward in faith! Because of David's faith and obedience to God's call, **the next thing you know, everyone is killing giants! 2 Samuel 21:15–22**

4. Will ______ stop hiding?

All these examples were written for us. **1 Corinthians 10:11**

God did not give you the spirit of fear. 2 Timothy 1:7

It was the FEAR-full servant that hid his talent! Luke 19:20-23

Like Adam, Gideon, Saul and David before you, God has called you. 2 Timothy 2:2; Matthew 28:19–20

The reasons for rebellion are the same today as they were for Eve. "Serving God is second rate!" The reasons for Adam: "I don't want to lose what I already have." Consider **2 Peter 3:10–14**

How much better to lose ALL for Christ! The principle: Matthew 16:25–27; 2 Timothy 2:11–13

The key? Go all in on Jesus.
