
## THE GOALS OF DISCIPLESHIP

Jesus gives 3 calls to follow:

- Come and see (John 1:37-51). A call to FOLLOW CHRIST
- Come and serve (Mark 1:17). A call to LEARN MINISTRY
- Come and sacrifice (Mark 8:34). A call to SACRIFICE SELF

When we talk about discipleship, we mean this whole process – adding all levels listed in 2 Peter 1 (faith virtue, knowledge, temperance, etc.). OHBC has 3 phases of discipleship ministry to guide the disciple through these 7 levels.



The goals that we are covering in this session are specifically for PERSONAL DISCIPLESHIP (AKA Discipleship 1). This is the beginning phase, intended verify the disciple's FAITH, and then add VIRTUE, KNOWLEDGE and begin to add TEMPERANCE.

## B. The role of the Worship of God

#### Principles to remember in establishing the disciple in the Worship of God:

1. A person \_\_\_\_\_\_ be discipled unless they are \_\_\_\_\_\_ to obey. Matthew 7:24-27

- Worship is a Biblical way to discern who is really serious and ready for discipleship.
- Worship is the decision of the disciple to respond in submission to God's goodness and God's sorrow.
   *Romans 2:4 2 Corinthians 7:10 John 6:66-69*
- It takes some longer than others to add this level, but it essential for discipleship.
- 2. Worship is a daily \_\_\_\_\_\_ of obedience that leads to growing in Christ-likeness.

## 3. How do we know the disciple has added virtue?

The first goal of Personal Discipleship is to establish the disciple in the Worship of God.

- Evidenced by voluntary obedience to truth
- Evidenced by continual, peaceful, eternal & powerful prayer.
- Evidenced by submission to believer's baptism.
- Evidenced by faithful stewardship.

- Evidenced by consistently seeking answers for life's issues from God's Word.
- Evidenced by faithfully attending and serving the church.
- Evidenced by relationships that include giving and receiving Biblical instruction, admonition and accountability.
- Evidenced by a life of contentment.

- Evidenced by fulfilling the spiritual role in the family
- Evidenced by involvement in evangelism
- Evidenced by involvement in discipleship

#### \*\*The 4 goals presented by the Living Faith Fellowship

The goals mentioned in this session are those adopted by Oakland Heights Baptist Church; other churches in the LFF also subscribe to these exact goals. However, the Living Faith Fellowship in general originated & maintains 4 goals:

- 1. Establish the Disciple in the Worship of God
- 2. Establish the Disciple in the Word of God
- 3. Establish the Disciple in the Local Church
- 4. Establish the Disciple in Ministry

Your church leadership may alter these to fit their view of the Bible's discipleship process.

- Evidenced by voluntary obedience to truth
- Evidenced by continual, peaceful, eternal & powerful prayer.
- Evidenced by submission to believer's baptism.
- Evidenced by faithful stewardship.
- 2) Establish the disciple in the Word of God: The principle of your life

Keyword: Knowledge (2 Peter 1:5) – EXPAND Who you know

- Evidenced by a consistent quiet time with the Lord.
- Evidenced by consistently seeking answers for life's issues from God's Word.
- Evidenced by faithfully attending and serving the church.
- Evidenced by relationships that include giving and receiving Biblical instruction, admonition and accountability.
- Evidenced by a life of contentment.
- **3)** Establish the disciple in the Work of God: The purpose of your life Keyword: Temperance (2 Peter 1:6) SOLIDIFY what you know
  - Evidenced by fulfilling the spiritual role in the family
  - Evidenced by involvement in evangelism
  - Evidenced by involvement in discipleship
